Subject: Discussion/Action - Approval of Hesperia Jr. High Paint Bid

RECOMMENDATION/SUGGESTED MOTION:

The Board approve the Hesperia Jr. High Paint Bid as recommended by staff to Painting and Decor, as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

BACKGROUND:

The District advertised Bid #17-107 for two weeks and sent seventeen (17) invitations to contractors to bid for the Painting Project at Hesperia Junior High School. A pre-bid job walk was held on April 24, 2017 at 9:00 a.m., there were six (6) contractors in attendance.

The district received bids from nine (9) contractors; Cam Painting, Mariscal Painting, Vera's Painting, Pacific Contractors Group, Color New, T&M Painting & Construction, Painting & Décor, Leo's A-C Inc., Economos Painting, Cramer Painting, which were opened on May 4, 2017, at 2:00pm.

Bids were evaluated by purchasing and maintenance and operation staff to ensure adherence to district specifications and responsiveness according to public contract code. District staff has reviewed the qualifications and pricing on this bid and found Painting and Decor to be most competitive.

RATIONALE:

Pursuant to Public Contract Code 20111(b), any public works project involving an expenditure of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) or more, shall be bid and awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder.

COST/FUNDING:

The cost of the painting project is \$163,700. The project will be paid from remaining certificate of participation construction funds.
