Subject: Discussion/Action - Approval of Provisional Internship Permit for Timothy Baum

RECOMMENDATION/SUGGESTED MOTION:

The Board approve the recommendation for a Provisional Internship Permit for Timothy Baum to teach Science, grades 7-8 at Hesperia Junior High School from August 7, 2019 through September 1, 2020.

BACKGROUND:

We are requesting a Provisional Internship Permit (PIP) for Timothy Baum to work as a Science Teacher at Hesperia Junior High School. A Provisional Internship Permit allows us to waive requirement(s) an applicant is missing to qualify for a credential. We would be waiving the CSET and pre-service requirement to qualify for his Internship program.

Timothy received his Bachelor's Degree in Biological Psychology from California State University, San Bernardino. He is currently enrolled in a credential program and upon completion of CSET and pre-service requirements he will be Intern eligible.

We feel very fortunate to have someone who is willing to complete the necessary requirements to become credentialed and highly qualified. Therefore, it is recommended that the Governing Board grant a Provisional Internship Permit for Timothy Baum for the period August 7, 2019 to September 1, 2020. His assignment will be Science Teacher, grades 7-8 at Hesperia Junior High School.

RATIONALE:

California is experiencing a statewide teacher shortage and after posting these positions multiple times, we are still not receiving applications for qualified candidates, so we have no other options than to hire individuals on a Provisional Internship Permit.
