Subject: Discussion/Action - Approval of Provisional Internship Permit for Paulo Robledo Jr.

RECOMMENDATION/SUGGESTED MOTION:

The Board approve the recommendation for a Provisional Internship Permit for Paulo Robledo Jr. to teach Mild/Moderate Special Education, grades 7-8 at Rancho Middle School from August 7, 2019 through September 1, 2020.

BACKGROUND:

We are requesting a Provisional Internship Permit (PIP) for Paulo Robledo Jr. to work as a Mild/Moderate Special Education Teacher at Rancho Middle School. A Provisional Internship Permit allows us to waive requirement(s) an applicant is missing to qualify for a credential. We would be waiving the CSET and pre-service requirement to qualify for his Internship program.

Paulo received his Bachelor's Degree in Liberal Studies from Azusa Pacific University. He is currently enrolled in an Education Specialist credential program with Azusa Pacific University. Upon completion of CSET and pre-service requirements he will be Intern eligible.

We feel very fortunate to have someone who is willing to complete the necessary requirements to become credentialed and highly qualified. Therefore, it is recommended that the Governing Board grant a Provisional Internship Permit for Paulo Robledo Jr. for the period August 7, 2019 to September 1, 2020. His assignment will be Mild/Moderate Special Education Teacher, grades 7-8 at Rancho Middle School.

RATIONALE:

California is experiencing a statewide teacher shortage and after posting these positions multiple times, we are still not receiving applications for qualified candidates, so we have no other options than to hire individuals on a Provisional Internship Permit.
