### **Day 2**

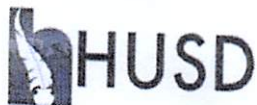
#### **Break Camp**

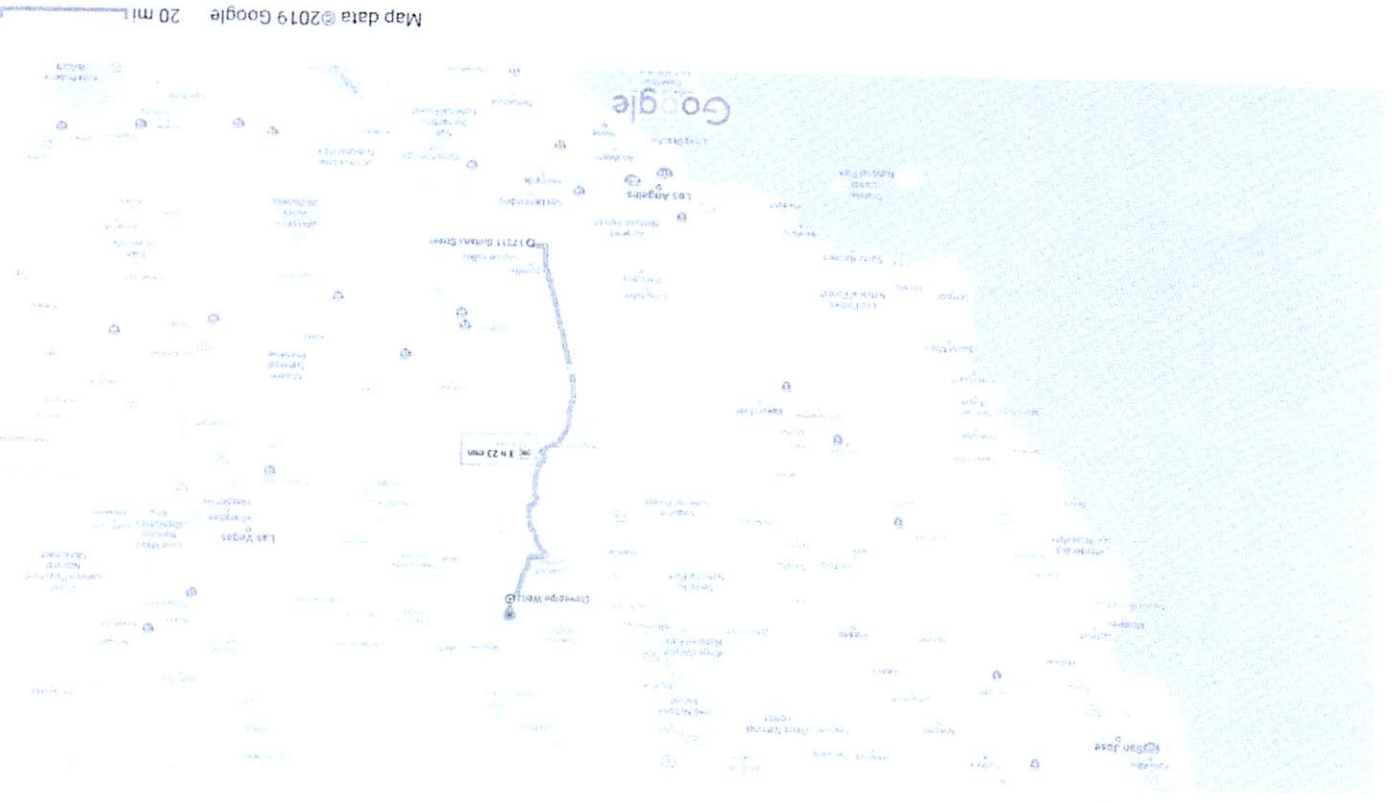
